Proposed Change to the ASOR By-Laws, Article 2, Section 2

Current by-laws, Article 2, Section 2:

The Corporation is the plenary body of ASOR and is composed of the various members listed above (Article II, Section 1, A-G). These shall meet annually at the time of the fall meeting of ASOR or at such time that the body itself may designate. They shall elect representatives to the Board of Trustees as specified in Article III, Section 2. These meetings shall be chaired by the chairperson of the Membership Committee.

Proposed by-law change:

The Corporation is the plenary body of ASOR and is composed of the various members listed above (Article II, Section 1, A-G). These shall meet annually at the time of the fall meeting of ASOR or at such time that the body itself may designate. They shall elect representatives to the Board of Trustees as specified in Article III, Section 2. These meetings shall be chaired by the ASOR President.

Proposed by-law change, with changes indicated in bold and strike-through:

The Corporation is the plenary body of ASOR and is composed of the various members listed above (Article II, Section 1, A-G). These shall meet annually at the time of the fall meeting of ASOR or at such time that the body itself may designate. They shall elect representatives to the Board of Trustees as specified in Article III, Section 2. These meetings shall be chaired by the **ASOR President** chairperson of the Membership Committee.

Rationale:

This proposed change to the by-laws comes from the membership and Outreach Committee and has been approved by the CCC. The Membership and Outreach Committee's rationale is as follows: "There are few public events at the annual meetings where the president's leadership is highlighted, and the Members' Meeting is probably the best venue for that."
