



5 Easy Steps for a Successful Virtual Annual Meeting (hint: do number 1 now)

- 1) Test your e-mail login on this page as soon as possible. The first time you open the Online Platform you will be asked to enter your e-mail address. The site will verify that you are registered, and you will be asked to check your e-mail for a message to complete your login. The e-mail will come from jaredkoller@asor.org and will contain a link to click that gives you full access to the Online Platform.
- 2) Once logged in, you will be able to access the full schedule of academic sessions by hovering over the "ANNUAL MEETING 2021" dropdown and clicking on "Session/Workshop Schedule" (red arrow). This is the portal to view Pre-Recorded Presentations, Posters, and to login for live sessions. We recommend viewing the pre-recorded material as soon as possible. With the exception of the Plenary Address and Workshops, paper presentations will not be given live or played-back during the online sessions. Please view the paper submissions before attending the sessions.




3) To view the pre-recorded presentations, click on the name of the session you wish to view (red arrow). This will take you to the sessions page where you will find a description of the session, be able to play pre-recorded presentations, and read abstracts. You can find sessions either by using the search function (blue arrow) or by scrolling through the various days. To join the live sessions, click on "VIEW SESSION" at the designated day and time.

VIRTUAL ANNUAL MEETING FORMAT

MEMBERS' MEETING & PLENARY ADDRESS: Wednesday, December 8 (1pm–3pm EST). The ASOR Members' Meeting will begin at 1pm followed by the Plenary Address at 2pm EST. Rather than a repeat of the live Plenary Address given at the In-Person Meeting in Chicago, there will be a Virtual Plenary Panel Discussion. 


SESSIONS: Thursday, December 9 – Sunday, December 12 beginning at 10:00am EST each day. Paper presentations are pre-recorded and posted to the Online Schedule. Presentations will not be given live or played back during the online session. Watch the recorded presentations before the online sessions so that you can fully participate in the discussions and Q&A.

These 1-hour long sessions are designed for Live Discussion and Q&A with paper presenters. It is strongly encouraged to start viewing presentations as soon as possible by <u>logging into ASOR's Virtual Annual Meeting Platform</u> and opening the Online Schedule.

WORKSHOPS: Thursday, December 9 (2:30pm-4:30pm EST) & Sunday, December 12 (2:30pm-4:30pm EST). These 2-hour online workshops are live. Presentations are not pre-recorded – they will be incorporated into the 2-hour online workshop.



ASOR 2021 ATTENDIFY

Continue the conversation on Attendify by clicking the "chat" button on each session page (red square).
