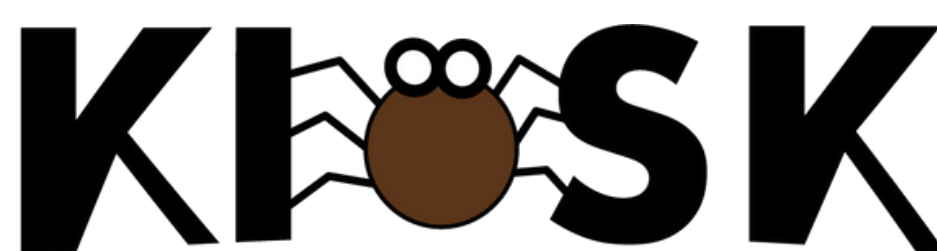

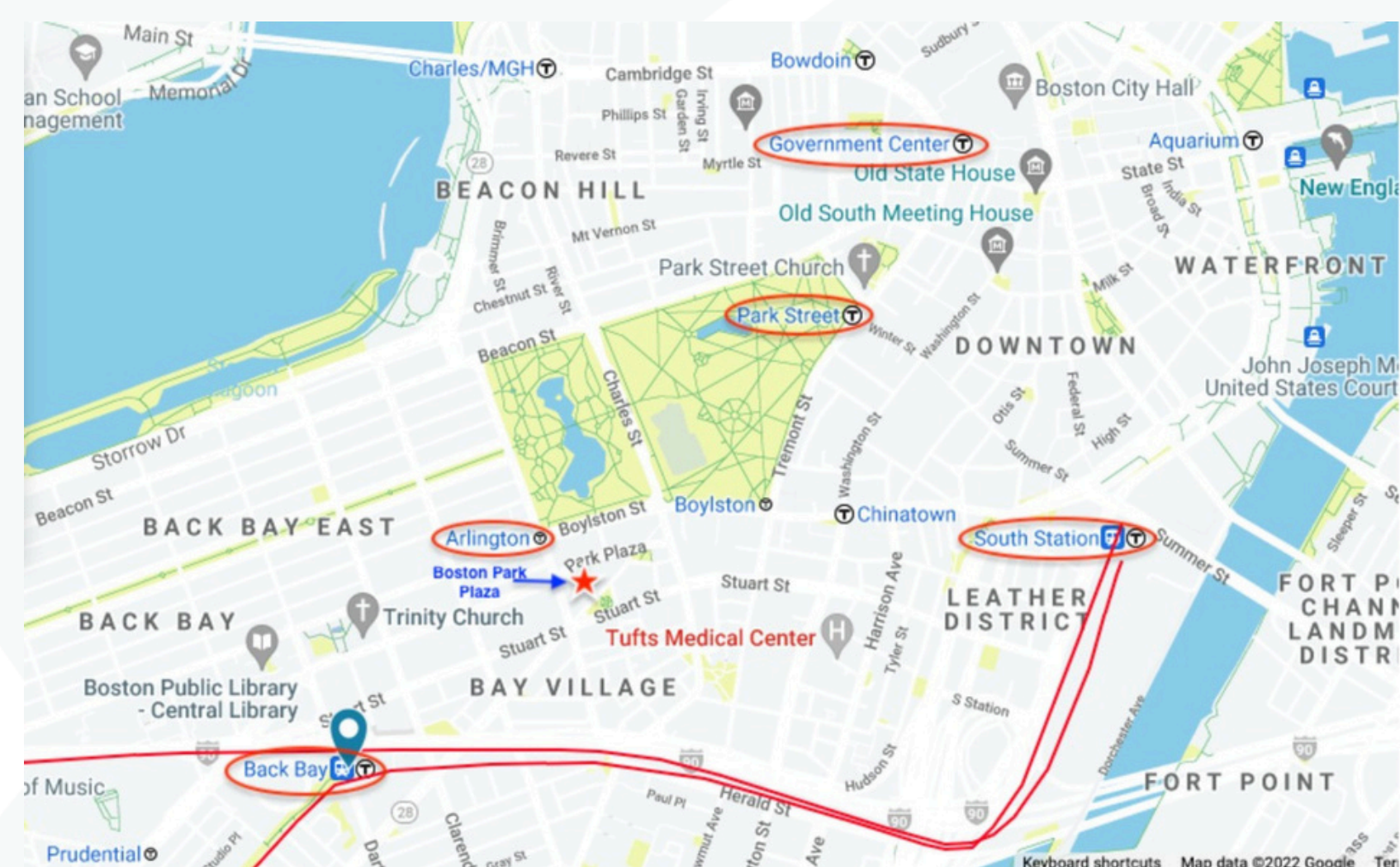

Getting Around:

Public Transportation is an easy and cheap option for getting around Boston.

The **MBTA**, or simply the “T”, is Boston’s inclusive transportation system. Use the MBTA [Trip Planner](#), which lets you plan your T ride from start to finish. A map of the T subways can be found [here](#).

The closest T stops to the Boston Park Plaza are the Arlington Street (Green Line) and Back Bay (Orange Line) Stations. From the airport you can take the blue line to Government Center and switch to the Green Line to Arlington T Station, which is approximately 500 feet from the hotel entrance. Other options include the Logan Express (LEX) from the airport to Back Bay Station (about a half mile from the hotel) or the free Silver Line bus to South Station (approximately .8 miles from the hotel).

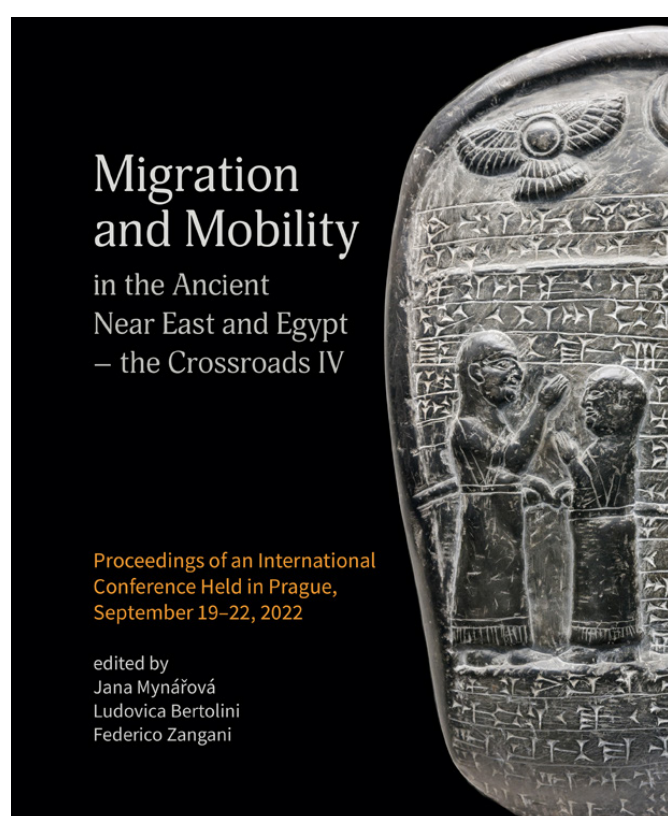
Oriental Mirages Stereotypes and Identity Creation in the Ancient World

Edward Said, in his seminal book *Orientalism*, perceived clear links between the ancient Greek and Roman stereotypes of the East and the prejudiced European nineteenth-century picture of the Muslim world, which was considered exotic, backward,

uncivilized, degenerate, and dangerous, in contrast with the Western societies that were seen as developed, rational, flexible, and, above all, superior. However, the reality is much more complex—shaped by both the imperialist perceptions of defeated enemies embraced by all Middle Eastern empires going back at least to the Assyrians, and the intermixed admiration and jealousy of the old “Eastern” traditions of learning.

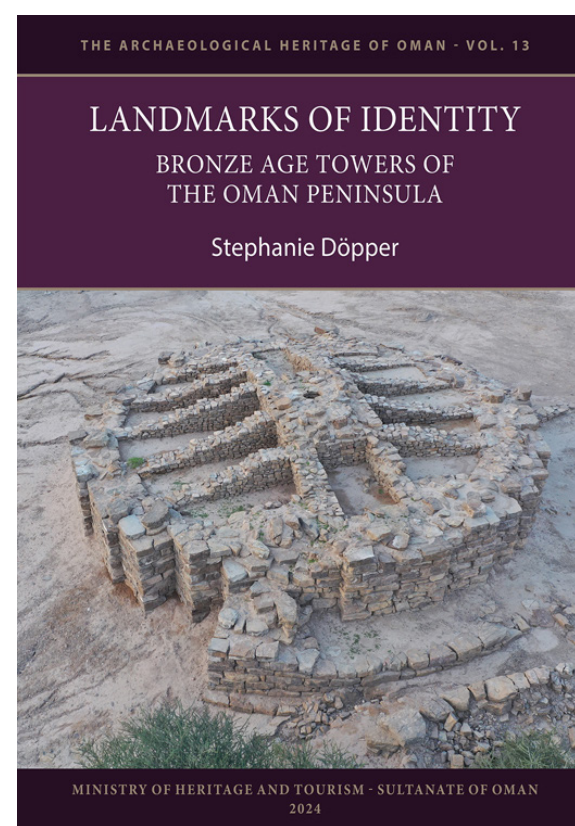

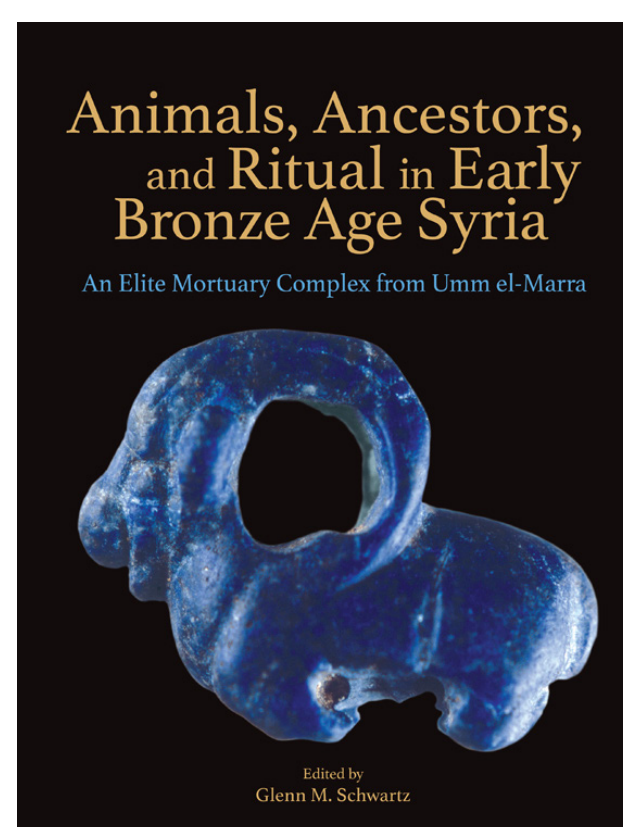
Landmarks of Identity Bronze Age Towers of the Oman Peninsula

Animals, Ancestors, and Ritual in Early Bronze Age Syria An Elite Mortuary Complex from Umm el-Marra

edited by Glenn M. Schwartz

This is the final report of the excavation of Tell Umm el-Marra in northern Syria, conducted in 1994–2010. It is likely the site of ancient Tuba, capital of a small kingdom in the Early and Middle Bronze periods, in the Jabbul plain between

Aleppo and northern Mesopotamia. Its study advances our understanding of early Syrian complex society beyond the big cities of Antiquity. Of particular importance in the Early Bronze excavations are the results from the site's necropolis. This site provides the first archaeological attestation of the kunga equids, unique in the archaeology of third-millennium Syria and Mesopotamia.
