



<u>LCP</u> 2025 Workshop: Hellenistic Pottery from Asia Minor Teos, Seferihisar, Turkey July 3rd-5th, 2025

The Levantine Ceramics Project (LCP) and the Teos Excavation project announce a workshop on the Hellenistic pottery of Asia Minor, to be held **July 3rd-5th**, **2025**, at the Teos excavation compound. This workshop will bring together scholars and students for open discussion and learning, and with the goal of adding material to the LCP so that this learning can be shared with others, now and in the future. One day of the workshop will be spent submitting vessels and related information to the LCP. Thus, we ask all participants to do the following in advance of the workshop:

- Rlease <u>register on the LCP</u>. When you do, make sure to check the box that says "Make me a contributor": <u>https://www.levantineceramics.org/users/sign_up</u>. Registering as a contributor means you receive credit for your submissions, e.g.,: Dündar, Erkan; Vessel: PTR.13.348.L-19.SU089-04, Site: Patara, The Levantine Ceramics Project, https://www.levantineceramics.org/vessels/27122-ptr-13-348-l-19-su089-04.
- 2. Select about 20 vessels for submission. Put this information in a spreadsheet or catalogue, beginning with individual registration number and archaeological context, as well as measurements, color & texture, surface treatment, firing, association with a specific ware, etc.
- 3. Compile drawings and photos. Photos do not need complicated set-ups. They can even be taken with a cell phone! We will be sending a short (1-minute) demonstration video. - 4. Lastly, bring this information with you on a computer or flash drive.
